



White Lake Community Native Landscape Initiative Tours Scheduled

Come and see the new native plant landscape at Alcoa Howmet!

You will learn about the Alcoa Howmet native landscape project coordinated by the Muskegon Conservation District – its purpose and design and how it fits into a larger native landscape initiative in the White Lake area. You will find out what is growing on the site – it's beautiful, by the way! You will also learn how the new landscape will help improve local water quality and contribute to our community's special quality of life.
